

INFORMATION CLAUSE

In accordance with art. 13 section 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal EU L 119 of 4 May 2016, p. 1) (hereinafter: GDPR), I would like to inform you that:

1. The administrators of your personal data are:
 - a. the Tadeusz Manteuffel Institute of History of Polish Academy of Sciences (hereinafter: IH PAN) seated in Warsaw, at 29/31 Rynek Starego Miasta;
 - b. Museum of Warsaw (hereinafter: Museum) seated in Warsaw, at 28/42 Rynek Starego Miasta,
who have concluded an agreement on the co-management of personal data.

3. IH PAN and the Museum will collect and process your personal data, including your image, for the purpose of organising and holding the conference 'How City is Formed? City-Making Processes in Warsaw, 14th—21th centuries. Diversity – Similarities – Contexts', including to:
 - a. register the conference participation,
 - b. communicate with participants on organisational matters,
 - c. document the course of the conference, including audio-visual recording,
 - d. provide a certificate of participation,
 - e. make it possible for IH PAN and the Museum to disseminate the conference materials and recordings on their websites and social media (Facebook, Instagram and Twitter).
4. Your personal data shall be processed throughout the entire period of the implementation of the activities for the scientific, educational and promotional purposes of IH PAN and Museum, and after the completion of the abovementioned activities they shall be stored for the mandatory archiving of the documentation for a period of time specified in separate regulations.
5. With regard to conference participants with a scientific paper and positive scientific reviews of the text, your personal data will also be processed for publishing purposes related to its publication.
6. With regard to your personal data, decisions shall not be taken in an automated manner.
7. You have the right to access your personal data, to rectify your personal data, to request the administrator to limit the processing of your personal data, with the reservation of the cases referred to in art. 18 clause 2 of the GDPR, as well as to lodge a complaint to the

President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

8. You do not have the right to delete your personal data, to transfer your personal data or the right to object to the processing of your personal data since the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 clause 1 the GDPR.
9. Providing your personal data in the application and consent to their processing and dissemination of the image is voluntary, and in case of refusal it will not be possible to attend the “How City is Formed? City-Making Processes in Warsaw, 14th—21th centuries. Diversity – Similarities – Contexts” conference.
